Paul's Karaoke

Paul's Karaoke meets in the Rose Room at the Rose Street Methodist Church usually on the middle two Wednesdays of each month. In August there is only one meeting on **Wednesday 15th August.** The group is open to anyone over the age of 16 who has a learning disability. There is a small charge of £3 per session.

@The Acorn Social Group

@The Acorn is our weekly social club for adults 16+ with learning disabilities, including those with profound and multiple learning disabilities. The club runs every Tuesday evening from 7.00pm-9.00pm at the Acorn Community Centre, Wooshehill. The activities in August include:

There is a small charge of £3 per person which includes drink, snacks and different activities every week. In light of current funding cuts, we are reviewing this weekly charge and may have to increase it.

Friday Alternative

This social group is for adults aged 16+ with Aspergers Syndrome/high functioning autism. Now that the TGIF and Friday Alternative groups have merged they meet twice a month. In August the next meetings are:
